RECITALS

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2013, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072 in an amount not to exceed \$561,000, wherein BHC, using its own trained labor force, shall manually gather, bag, and pile litter from alongside designated roadways and other designated areas using up to three crews of five (5) people each and one (1) working supervisor and up to one (1)crew of three (3) people each and one (1)working supervisor from BHC on a schedule as determined by CITY; and

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2014, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072 (1) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$690,640 with a termination date of June 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, on May 21st, 2014, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(2) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$840,640 with a termination date of June 30th, 2015; and

WHEREAS, on June 24th, 2015, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(3) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$1,402,228 with a termination date of June 30th, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on June 08, 2016, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(4) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$1,963,816 with a termination date of June 30th, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on June 07, 2017, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(5) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to to an amount not to exceed \$2,525,404 with a termination date of June 30th, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on June 06, 2018, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(6) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$3,117,044 with a termination date of June 30th, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2019, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(7) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$3,661,684 with the termination date of June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072(8) whereby the contract total compensation amount was increased to an amount not to exceed \$4,157,324 with the termination date of June 24, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2021, CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072 (9) to increase compensation by Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for a total compensation not to exceed Four Million Two Hundred and Seven Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$4,207,324) and to add a 4th crew; and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2021, CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072 (10) to increase compensation by Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Six Hundred Forty (\$957,640) for a total compensation not to exceed Five Million One Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four Dollars (\$5,164,964) to add an additional 5th crew and extend the term of the agreement to June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2022, CITY and BHC entered into Agreement No. 13-072 (11) merging into its sister agency, Alliance Against Family Violence and Sexual Assault, forming a new entity known as The Open Door Network, and increased the compensation for a total compensation not to exceed Five Million One Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Four Dollars (\$5,164,964), and extended the term of the agreement to June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2022, CITY and The Open Door Network amended Agreement No. 13-072 to increase compensation by Three Hundred and Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000) for a total compensation not to exceed Six Million Forty-Five Thousand Six Hundred and Four Dollars (\$6,045,604) to continue highway litter removal services; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2022, CITY and The Open Door Network amended Agreement No. 13-072 to change the compensation rate starting January 1, 2023 from \$26.47 per hour to \$26.97 per hour, due to the increase in California minimum wage; and

WHEREAS, CITY and CONTRACTOR desire to amend Agreement No. 13-072 to increase compensation by Eight Hundred Seven Thousand Six Hundred Forty Dollars (\$807,640) for a total compensation not to exceed Six Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Four Dollars (\$6,853,244) and extend the Term of the Agreement to June 30, 2024 to continue highway litter removal services.

NOW, THEREFORE, incorporating the foregoing recitals herein, CITY and The Open Door Network mutually agree to amend Agreement as follows:

- 1. Section No. 2 of Agreement No. 13-072, entitled "COMPENSATION" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 2. <u>COMPENSATION</u>. Compensation for all work, services or products called for under this Agreement shall be payable in accordance with section 3. "Payment Procedure" as stated below but in no event shall exceed Six Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Four Dollars (\$6,853,244) for the life of the contract.
 - 2.1 The compensation set forth in this section shall be the total compensation under the Agreement including, but not limited to all out-of-pocket costs and taxes. CITY shall pay only the compensation listed unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties. Compensation shall be made in a per crew basis, but crew sizes may vary. The fee for service will remain based on a \$26.97 per hour rate per person through June 30, 2024. Calculating the hourly rate based on starting at the time the crew leaves their facility to the time the crew returns to their facility and does not include a 30-minute lunch break. Weekly safety training is included as part of the payment period.
 - 2. Section No. 9 of Agreement No. 13-072, entitled "**TERM**" is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - **9.** <u>**TERM.**</u> Unless terminated sooner, as set forth herein, this Agreement shall expire on June 30, 2024.
 - 3. Except as amended herein, all other provisions of Agreement No. 13-072, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
